DORM STYLE

There are two Residence Halls (A & B). Each consist of two wings with a large lounge and two restroom/shower areas in the central area. The halls have been arranged with more spacing between the bunks and a reduced number of participants per wing. Residence Hall A will be "Ladies Only".

Residence Hall B has been designated as our "Couples" hall. Gents are housed in one wing, & ladies in the other, each wing with their own restroom & showers.

No one sleeps in an upper bunk. There are hospital beds with electric power adjustments available. There are sufficient electrical outlets for CPAP machines, device chargers, etc.

SEMI-PRIVATE ACCOMMODATIONS

The Greif house provides semi-private housing options to participants. This newer building provides a fine alternative to "dorm" housing without driving to and from a motel. The Greif House provides semi-private housing for 2, 3, or 6 people in private "pods" which include restroom facilities.

BUCKEYE DULCIMER FESTIVAL IS...

...a unique opportunity for acoustic instrument players to meet, learn and play together. We're focused on making your music experience a rewarding one!

Wednesday afternoon kicks off the festival with an early bird class, jamming, a flag raising, dinner, orientation and meeting your instructors. Fun and games! Jamming will start the evening, but make sure to get to bed early so you are rested for the activities to come.

After breakfast, our Thursday and Friday extended sessions include 3 hours of in-depth, intensive instruction for Mountain and Hammered Dulcimer, Autoharp, Clawhammer Banjo and "Band-it!".

After lunch, we will continue the intensive instruction, and then there will be a variety of other activities planned for each afternoon. Evenings present opportunities for a variety of jams; a slower jam for those who enjoy a moderate tempo, and another for those who love the thrill of high speed jammin'. Opportunities for performing on "open stage" will be available.

Sit back, relax and enjoy the Friday and Saturday night concerts by our amazing instructors. Following the concerts will be time for jamming or socializing by the fireplace in the lodge.

Vendors will arrive on Friday afternoon so you will have an excellent opportunity to purchase musical instruments, supplies, books, and CDs throughout the weekend.

The Saturday afternoon schedule will include our popular "cake walk"... make sure to bring your quarters.

Wednesday and Thursday, there will be space available for you to bring in music-

related items that you would like to sell. We are also accepting donations of music-related items that will be silent-auctioned and/or raffled to benefit continuation of the festival. Larger items will also be posted so our "online" Buckeye Dulcimer family can participate, too.

The festival concludes on Sunday morning with our traditional Gospel Sing, brunch, final bids on raffle items, and good-byes.

Due to last year's success, we will again offer the Intermediate/Adv. Mountain & Hammered Dulcimer sessions, and the Autoharp and Clawhammer Banjo sessions as a zoom/hybrid. Off-site participants will be able to take the 10-hour extended sessions via Zoom. As an added bonus, this technology gives in-person participants better sound and a great view via a large-screen TV showing the instructors hands and instrument close-up.
